



DIPLOMA OF THEOLOGY

The **Diploma of Theology** is designed for students who previously earned a Certificate of Christian Training (CCT) and desire to further explore the Christian faith and certain areas of church work build on religious foundation offered through additional non- credit courses approved at extension site. DT applicants must be high school graduates or present equivalency certificates from having passed the General Education Development (GED) Tests: high school level.

Upon diploma completion, students should (in addition to the objectives listed for the CCT):

- have a larger perspective of the theology, and doctrine of the Christian faith as expressed throughout the Bible; and
- have a greater insight as to how this theology and doctrine can further enrich his or her ministry in the local church setting.

Course substitutions used toward a CCT cannot be used to satisfy Diploma of Theology course requirements. The Extension Site Director and/or the Director of the Division of Continuing Education may submit course substitutions to the Academic Dean for approval.
