



TRANSFER OF CREDIT

American Baptist College will accept semester hours only for all transfer work. We will accept course content only for 'D' grades; however, a student will not earn hours toward graduation for 'D' work completed at another college or university. The student's grade point average will be determined by the work completed at American Baptist College.

Transferring credits from accredited institutions and programs—ABC will accept credits from other accredited institutions in the following manner and under the following conditions:

As long as there is a reasonable equivalent in the ABC Catalogue, we will accept a course. "Reasonable equivalents" are courses that are applicable toward bachelor's degrees in the liberal arts tradition.

The College will accept all courses—to a maximum of 45 semester hours toward programs approved for the B.A. degree.

Students who have attained an A.A. degree or equivalent from an accredited institution will be allowed to transfer course credits meeting the ABC core course requirements into the B.A. program for degree completion. Students must complete the last 45 credit hours of major courses and 15 hours of upper level electives in residency to graduate from a B.A. degree program at American Baptist College.
